Key Information

Shelter **Schools are to bring their own gazebo for use on the day. Please See map. Gazebo may be stored at ARSS for the week.**

Transport/Parking Buses, please drop off in Nyngam St in front of gate 7. If Buses are remaining throughout the day please park on Mortimer Rd. Mini Buses can access the school drop off and pick up zone. Parents please utilise street parking on Nyngam St. throughout the day. Rules:

To decide who starts the game Toss coin or scissor, paper, rock

Clearing the ball When the defending team get possession of the ball, they must bring it outside the 3-point arc in order to 'clear' the ball. Once clear they may start to score

Scoring 1 point is awarded for shots inside and 3 points outside the arc.

Time The game will consist of two 9-minute halves with a 2-minute half time break. A siren will alert the beginning of each game as well as the end of the first half or end of game.

Fouls A foul is anytime a player breaks a rule in the game

Blocking Illegal blocking happens when an opposing player makes personal contact that disrupts a player with or without the ball

Charging When a player is moving in an established path with the ball and uses their body against the opponent

Hacking Hacking is when a defensive player hits the person holding the ball
