- Increase the percentage of Prep students achieving at or above PM Reading Level 5 to 60%.
- Increase A-E ratings from Prep to Year 6 to 70% of students achieving C or above in English.

Our initiatives include

- Implementing research and evidence-based explicit instruction of Reading using the Big 6 including Oral language, Phonemic awareness, Synthetic phonics, Fluency, Vocabulary and Comprehension.
- Sustained on-site professional development in explicit instruction involving school visits by John Fleming.
- Supplementary staffing to maintain class structure and flexibly manage complex students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Providing time for teachers to engage in development and delivery activities including planning and watching others work. **\$21 449**
- Targetted deployment of Specialist staff to increase engagement and achievement including: Speech Language Pathologist, Inclusion teacher, Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy, Reading teacher aides. **\$231 454**
